Discover 11 acres of beautiful borders and vistas - the culmination of a lifetime of passion for gardening and an admiration of the tradition of the English Country Garden. These award winning gardens are family owned and maintained - visitors often express delight at the attention to detail displayed throughout and the intimate, peaceful atmosphere.

All the ingredients of the English Country Garden are present ... then, of course, the plants! Borders overflowing with perennials and annuals – the look changing through the seasons, but always abundantly filled, and each garden ‘room’ planted in a different colour theme. Pashley is also renowned for fantastic displays of tulips, roses and dahlias. The annual *Tulip Festival* features over 40,000 tulips!

Add to all this a Café and Terrace with excellent garden views; Sculpture and Art Exhibitions; a Gift Shop with Plant Sales; group rates, free coach parking, coach driver incentives and a friendly, knowledgeable team waiting to welcome you, and the recipe for a wonderful day out is complete.

We recommend a minimum of 2 hours to visit the Gardens (the house is not open to the public), however, most stay longer than this, enjoying the delicious lunches and teas available from our Café.

THE GARDEN ROOM CAFÉ

As well as coming to see the beautiful gardens groups should ‘allow time to sample the fabulous homemade food and warm hospitality at arguably the best garden café in the county, much of which is sourced from the abundant kitchen garden’ (Leigh Clapp in ‘Sussex Life’).

- GARDEN ROOM CAFÉ - seats 60 indoors.
- COURTYARD and TERRACE - sit under parasols or in the sun with beautiful views of the garden.
- BUFFET STYLE SERVICE - please let us know if your group will be with us for refreshments (see order form) but there is **no need to pre-book refreshments** - visitors often enjoy choosing from our tempting buffet selection on an individual basis.
- PRE-PAID MENUS FOR GROUPS can be booked if you prefer (see order form). Please note that during the Tulip Festival and Craft Show the café operates with a slightly different menu so refreshments cannot be pre-booked during these two events.
- PICNICS - Picnics may be taken in the Car Park field where there are a few picnic tables and benches. We regret picnics may not be taken in the Gardens. Please ensure you take all of your litter home with you.

GIFT SHOP & PLANT SALES / SCULPTURE & ART EXHIBITIONS

The Gift Shop caters for every taste; from postcards and local honey to garden tools, hand painted ceramics and beautiful scarves. A selection of plants, many of which grow at Pashley, are available for purchase. There is an exhibition of Botanical/Floral paintings in the Garden Room Café and an exhibition of Sculpture in the gardens all through the season (most pieces are for sale).

CONDUCTED TOURS

- Full tour around the garden (approx. 60 minutes) - led by an experienced garden guide. The cost for up to 25 people is £162.00, plus Admission Fee.
- Introductory talk (usually given in front of the house; 15/20 minutes) at a cost of £52.00 for up to 35–45 people, plus Admission Fee. This talk gives a brief history of Pashley Manor and the gardens.

A DAY IN THE AREA

Add a trip to another local attraction to complement your visit to the gardens at Pashley and make a full day out. We offer a joint tour with Great Dixter House and Gardens. Begin your day in the traditional splendour of the gardens at Pashley followed by lunch (not included in the price) and then on to Great Dixter House and Garden in the afternoon. *Please ask if you would like more details, prices and a booking form for this tour.*

Alternatively, there are many other attractions - gardens, historic houses, vineyards, railways in the surrounding area - do ask us if you would like an idea of what is located nearby.

BOOKING PROCEDURE:

- Call or email to check the day you would like to visit is available (space is restricted so early booking is recommended - particularly during the Tulip Festival and other events) and we will pencil you in.
- Then complete the booking form and send to us with your deposit to confirm the booking.
- Should you wish to arrange a group visit at the last moment you are always welcome to get in touch and we will do our very best to fit you in.
- Upon receipt of your group booking form we will send a letter of confirmation and a receipt to present on the day of your visit. The balance must be paid on or before the day of the visit (if paying on the day of the visit the Organiser must collect entrance money before the visit and present one payment on arrival), **please note we do not invoice after the event.**

DEPOSIT PAYMENT:

Sadly, we have experienced late cancellations in the past, therefore we have reluctantly had to impose a £50.00 booking charge, which is refundable in the event of cancellations notified to us more than 14 days before the visit.

During the Tulip Festival we have occasionally had to turn away bookings, so we will require a £100 deposit per coach/group to secure a booking. Please note: Tulip Festival deposits are non-refundable.

DISABLED & LESS ABLE VISITORS:

Disabled visitors are made most welcome. The gardens are only partially accessible - the formal gardens, terrace, gift shop and cafe are all accessible but the steeper gravel paths towards the woodland and behind the ponds are difficult to navigate. Due to the sloping nature of the garden, and the gravel/grass paths throughout, motorised wheelchairs are advised or a strong person to push!

We advise you to telephone before visiting so that we may give you full details of access to ensure a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience. For some groups of disabled visitors we recommend each disabled visitor brings a companion as distances within the garden can be tiring. We have two wheelchairs (non-motorised) which we loan (booking advised) and lavatory facilities. Also see 'Parking' below.

COACH PARKING, FROM THE COACH TO THE GARDEN & COACH DRIVERS:

Parking is available for up to 5 coaches (and there is ample parking for cars). For pre-booked groups of 15+ coach drivers enter the gardens free of charge, and will be presented with a refreshment voucher at the Reception/Gift Shop. We can send a car up to the coach park to bring less able visitors to the garden entrance if requested - please let us know before your visit, if possible, and/or on arrival let the reception team know if any transport to/from the coach park is required. NB: Pashley has two driveways - one signposted 'Coaches and Deliveries' the other drive is marked by the Tourist Brown signpost (this drive is suitable for access to the Car Park only - coaches must use the designated Coach drive).
